The Deaf Golf Australia (DGA) executive committee is delighted to announce an exciting new fundraising solution - thanks to the support of Deaf Sports Australia (DSA).

DGA operates in partnership with both DSA and the Australian Sports Foundation (ASF) in helping source and raise funds from community organisations and supporters from all over the country.

Funds raised through this partnership means that donations of \$2 or more are tax deductible, which is a real benefit to donors and makes fundraising easier. All funds donated through this facility will ensure that the money will be redirected to specific DGA campaigns.

Funds currently are earmarked to help subsidise travel & registration costs for each team member qualified to play WDGC 2018 in Ireland. The facility is set up to receive funds not just for Ireland 2018, but also subsequent WDGC campaigns in the future.

This facility makes it possible for golfers (individual or team) to receive funds the donor wishes to nominate. Payment can be made by either credit card or BSB (EFT) fund transfer - if BSB you will be sent an email with instructions.
